Henriette Solberg Jæger, PhD, is a researcher and molecular biologist at the Center for Laboratory Medicine at Østfold Hospital Kalnes. She completed her PhD at the University of Oslo, studying the diagnostic potential of circulating biomarkers in the hyperacute phase of stroke.

Henriette is working in the Research and Competence Group for Molecular Biology where she conducts self-initiated research projects and is actively involved in biomarker analyses for other research groups at Østfold Hospital Kalnes. She is also affiliated the Norwegian Air Ambulance Foundation and contributes to several stroke-related research projects.

At this conference, she will present her work, focusing on how different centrifugation strategies impact plasma levels of microRNA.
